Are you a man who has sex with men?

Have you ever been diagnosed with bowel cancer?

We are a research team from the University of East London exploring the experiences of men who have sex with men and the impact bowel cancer has on their sexuality and intimacy.

WHO CAN TAKE PART?

To be eligible you must:

- Be a UK resident
- Be over the age of 18
- Self-identify as a man who has sex with men
- Have been diagnosed with bowel cancer
- Be in remission and completed any treatment six months ago.

WHAT WILL THE RESEARCH INVOLVE?

Taking part will involve a one-to-one interview, either by video call or telephone, lasting no more than one hour. You will be asked about the impact bowel cancer has had on your sexuality and/or relationships and how you have navigated any changes. It is a chance for you to share your experiences in a confidential and non-judgemental space. All information will be kept anonymous.
